Project Scope: The Lands & Survey Department acting on behalf of the Ministry of District Administration, Planning, Agriculture and Housing, Cayman Islands Government (CIG), invites qualified bidders to submit a fixed priced proposal in US\$ for the provision of vertical ortho-rectified digital imagery and associated work as described in the documents which are available online at the link below.

Description of Services: The Department maintains and manages the Government’s Geographic Information Systems, which operates in an ESRI ArcGIS environment. Digital imagery forms a key layer within the system. A new data set to support the land management activity, land surveying activities, road design and construction and property management is now required due to the continuing development of the Cayman Islands. This data will be used in the Department’s Land Information System

Definitions:

Project Scope – The Lands & Survey Department will require the acquisition of vertical ortho-rectified digital imagery and mapping of all 3 islands, the supply of a Digital Terrain Model (DTM) and Digital Surface Model (DSM) and related products of the Cayman Islands, and updated topographical mapping as per the minimum specifications outlined in the bid document.
