THIS IS NOT A CLAIM FORM.

If you intend to make a claim for compensation you must complete this form (Form A), and it must be received at the address below **WITHIN 90 DAYS OF PUBLICATION IN THE GAZETTE** of the relevant notice under section 3 of the Roads Law (2005 Revision) relating to your land. The date of publication in the Gazette is the declared day. **If you do not return the form in time you will lose the right to make a claim for compensation, unless you can show good cause for the delay.**

To make a claim for compensation you must complete a claim form (Form B) which may be filed with the Lands Officer at any time after you file this form **BUT NO LATER THAN ONE YEAR AFTER THE PROPOSED ROAD IS SCHEDULED AS A PUBLIC ROAD** pursuant to section 5 (1) (b) of the Roads Law (2005 Revision).

Para. 1 - This Notice of Intention to Make a Claim applies to the claimant named in paragraph 1 only. Any other persons who have an interest in the land must submit separate Notices.

Para 5. - Please give details of all other persons who occupy or have an interest in the land, including joint owners, tenants and contracting purchasers.

Para 6. - Please provide the fullest possible details of buildings or other items upon the land which will be affected by the proposed road, including numbers and species of trees and approximate acreages of any standing crops. At a later date, you will be contacted to arrange a site visit. At that time you will have the opportunity to review the items which you have listed in paragraph 6(a). You will also be provided with further information to assist in formulating your claim. Any outlay or improvement on or disposal of the land which are commenced, made or effected without the approval of the Governor after the declared day will not be taken into consideration for compensation.

Para. 7 - You are not obliged to appoint an agent to act on your behalf. If you decide to do so, please provide details as indicated. You may also be required to provide a letter of authorisation. Once you have appointed an agent, all future correspondence will be with him and he will be deemed to have full authority to act on your behalf unless the Valuation Officer receives written notice from you revoking that authority.

The NRA will consider claims for compensation and/or refer claims to the Assessment Committee. The NRA has appointed the Lands and Survey Department ("LSD") to act on their behalf on all matters relating to the claim for compensation including processing these claim forms. The NRA and/or LSD will engage with other persons to advise on or assist with processing claims made under the Act as necessary. The information collected from these persons will not be shared with any unauthorized persons and/or organizations. However, the information provided may be reported to other Government agencies/Departments to obtain relevant information in order to make an informed decision on the claim.
